

EYE Live Community Guidelines

1. Introduction

At EYE Live, our mission is to create the world's first personal sports social network with ground-breaking wearable technology. To achieve this goal, we ask that all users participate in such a way that promotes a friendly, positive experience for our community.

In addition to our [Terms and Conditions](#) we provide the following guidelines for our community. These guidelines fall under a common sense philosophy and apply to all user generated content and activity on our services. This is considered a living document that we regularly update based on the evolution of the EYE Live community and service.

2. User Conduct

2.1. Account Suspensions

To protect the integrity of our community, as the provider of the service, we at EYE Live reserve the right to suspend any account at any time for any conduct that we determine to be inappropriate or harmful. Such actions may include: removal of content, a strike on the account, and/or suspension of account(s). Please refer to the [Terms and Conditions](#) for more information.

All suspensions are binding until expiration or removal upon appeal. Any attempt to circumvent an account suspension by using other accounts, identities, personalities, or presence on another user's account will also result in suspension. Suspension evasion will not only increase the length of suspension, but may lead to an indefinite suspension.

2.2. Spam, Scams, and Other Malicious Conduct

Any content or activity that disrupts, interrupts, harms, or otherwise violates the integrity of EYE Live services or another user's experience or devices is prohibited. You may not use the EYE Live services, or assist or encourage any other party, to engage in attempting to disrupt, degrade, impair or violate the integrity or security of the EYE Live services or the computers, services, user accounts or networks of any other party.

Such activity includes:

- Engaging in or permitting any network or hosting activity that results in the blacklisting or other blockage of Arenberg or EYE internet protocol Space
- Activity that typically precedes attempts to breach security such as scanning, probing or other testing or vulnerability assessment activity
- Phishing, hacking, Denial of service attacks and spreading malware or viruses
- Defrauding others, misinformation and tampering
- Distributing unauthorised advertisements
- Selling or sharing user accounts
- Defacing, or attempting to deface, website pages or other EYE Live services (such as uploading inappropriate or malicious content)
- Posting large amounts of repetitive, unwanted messages or user reports

3. Violence and Criminal Behaviour

3.1. Breaking the Law

You must respect all applicable local, national, and international laws while using our services. Any content or activity featuring, encouraging, offering, or soliciting illegal activity is prohibited.

3.2. Self-Destructive Behaviour

Any activity that may endanger your life or lead to your physical harm is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to: suicide threats, intentional physical trauma, illegal use of drugs, illegal or dangerous consumption of alcohol, trespass and dangerous or distracted driving.

3.3. Violence and Threats

Acts and threats of violence will be taken seriously and are considered zero-tolerance violations and all accounts associated with such activities will be indefinitely suspended. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Attempts or threats to physically harm or kill others
- Attempts or threats to hack, DDOS, or SWAT others
- Use of weapons to physically threaten, intimidate, harm, or kill others

4. Safety

4.1. Hateful Conduct and Harassment

Hateful conduct is any content or activity that promotes, encourages, or facilitates discrimination, denigration, objectification, harassment, or violence based on race, ethnicity, national origin, religion, sex, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, age, disability, medical condition or physical characteristics and is prohibited. Any hateful conduct is considered a zero-tolerance violation. We will take action on all accounts associated with such conduct with a range of enforcement actions, including and up to indefinite suspension.

Harassment is any content or activity that attempts to intimidate, degrade, abuse, or bully others, or creates a hostile environment for others, and is prohibited. Depending on the severity of the offense, your account may be indefinitely suspended on the first violation.

We prohibit using EYE Live to facilitate hateful conduct or harassment, whether the targets are on or off EYE Live. Individuals, communities or organisations that do so are not allowed to use our services. We may take action against users for hateful conduct or harassment that occurs off EYE Live services that is directed at EYE Live users.

4.2. Nudity, Pornography, and Other Sexual Content

Nudity and sexually explicit content or activities, such as pornography, sexual acts or intercourse, and sexual services, are prohibited. Content or activities that threaten or promote sexual violence or exploitation are strictly prohibited and may be reported to law enforcement. Child exploitation will be reported to authorities.

4.3. Unauthorised Sharing of Private Information

Do not invade the privacy of others. It is prohibited to share content that may reveal private personal information about individuals, or their private property, without permission. This includes but is not limited to:

- Sharing personally identifiable information (such as real name, location, or ID)
- Sharing restricted or protected social profiles or any information from those profiles
- Sharing content that violates another's reasonable expectation of privacy

- Collecting or harvesting any information relating to an identified or identifiable individual (such as their user account names and information about the user)

5. Integrity and authenticity

You may not use the EYE Live services, or assist or encourage any other party, to engage in any act or omission that is false, inaccurate or misleading or deceptive.

Content or activity meant to impersonate an individual or organisation is prohibited.

6. Respecting Intellectual Property

You should only share content on EYE Live that you own, or that you are otherwise authorised to share on EYE Live. If you share content on EYE Live that you do not own or otherwise do not have the rights to share on EYE Live, you may be infringing another person's intellectual property rights. This includes any third party content included in your content, derivative creations, or performances of others' copyrighted content. We encourage you to assess your content for adherence to applicable intellectual property laws and the proper application of principles such as Fair Dealing under the *Copyright Act 1968* (Cth), and to secure all appropriate rights needed, before sharing your content on EYE Live.

Any unauthorised content you share on EYE Live may be subject to a takedown by the rights holder(s) to remove the infringing content from EYE Live, and is a violation of our Terms and Conditions and Community Guidelines. Multiple violations of our policies may lead to a permanent suspension of your account.

Examples of content you cannot share on EYE Live without permission from the copyright owners or other authorisation include:

- Sharing other EYE Live creators' content
- Sharing content from other sites
- Showing movies, television shows, or sports matches
- Playing music you do not own or do not have the rights to share

7. Content-related requests

Each of us is an important part of the EYE Live community. If you see something that you think may violate our guidelines, please help us by using our reporting options. We have a team that reviews these reports and works as quickly as possible to remove content that doesn't meet our guidelines. Even if you or someone you know doesn't have an EYE Live account, you can still file a report. When you complete the report, try to provide as much information as possible, such as links, usernames, and descriptions of the content, so we can find and review it quickly. We may remove entire posts if either the imagery or associated captions violate our guidelines.

You may find content you don't like, but doesn't violate the Community Guidelines. If that happens, you can unfollow or block the person who posted it. If there's something you don't like in a comment on one of your posts, you can report that comment.

Many disputes and misunderstandings can be resolved directly between members of the community. If one of your photos or videos was posted by someone else, you could try asking the person to take

it down. If that doesn't work, you can file a copyright report or a trade mark report directly with Arenberg at info@arenberg.co.
